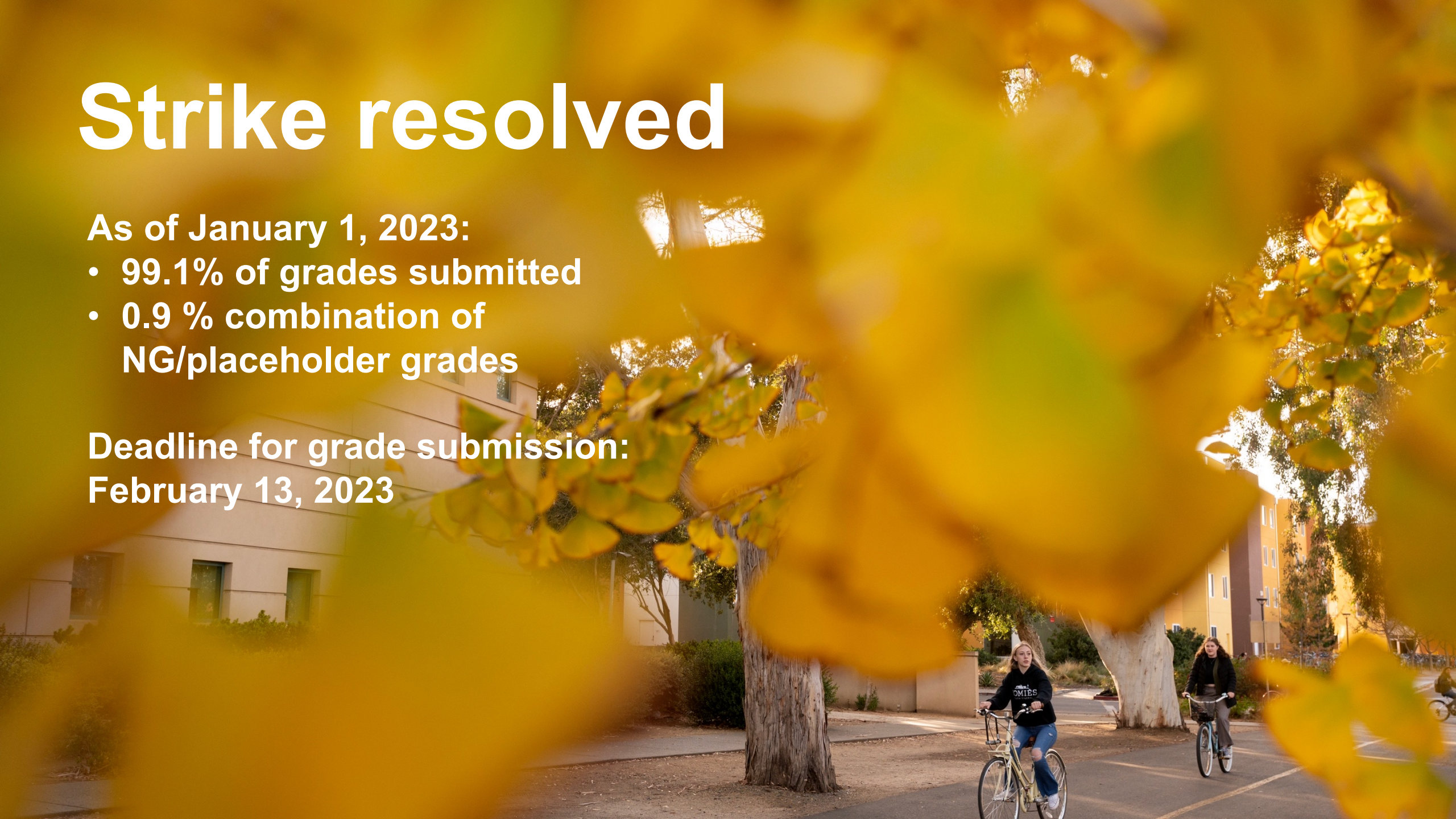


Strike resolved

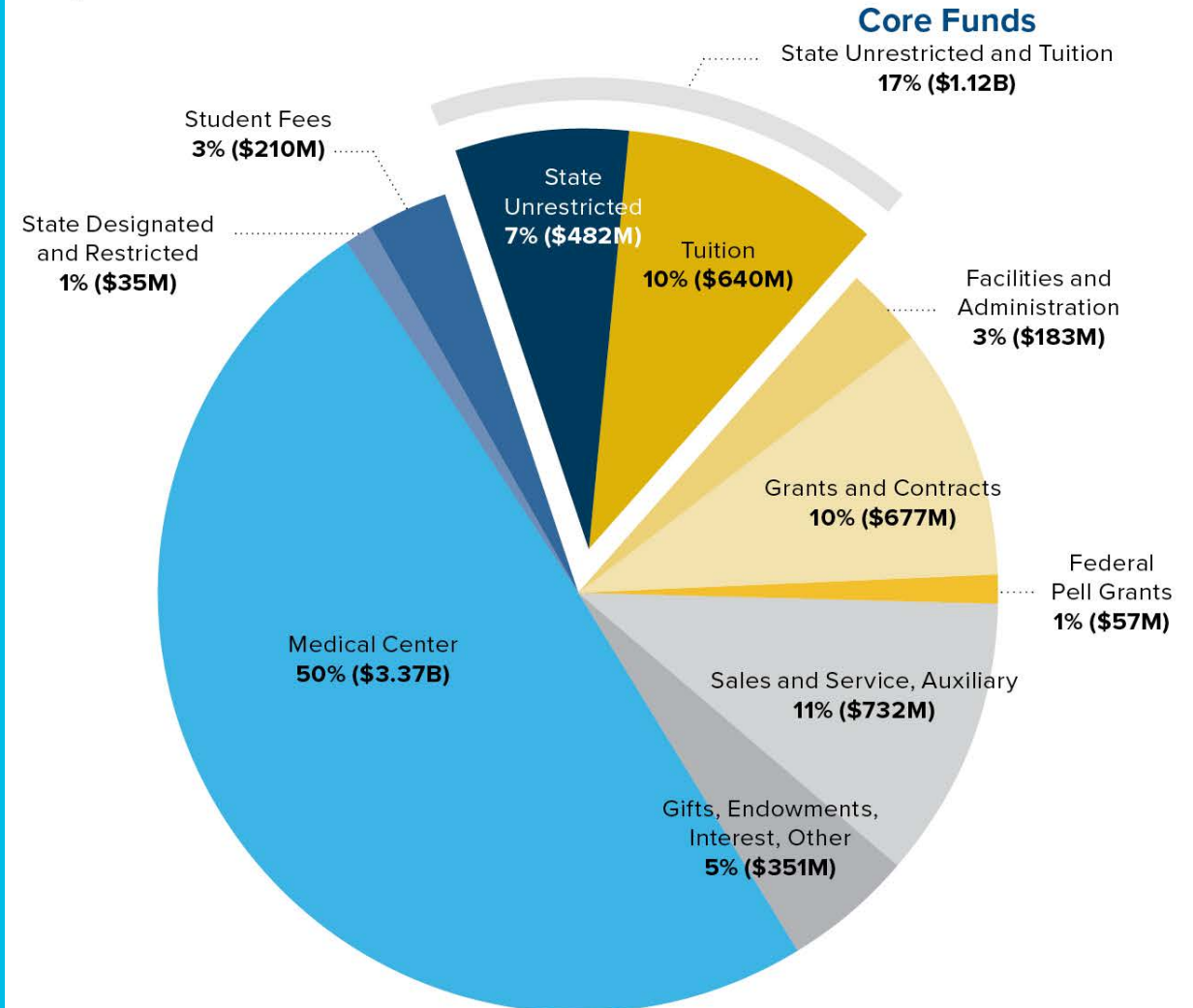

The university reached a major new milestone, attracting more than \$1 billion in annual research awards.



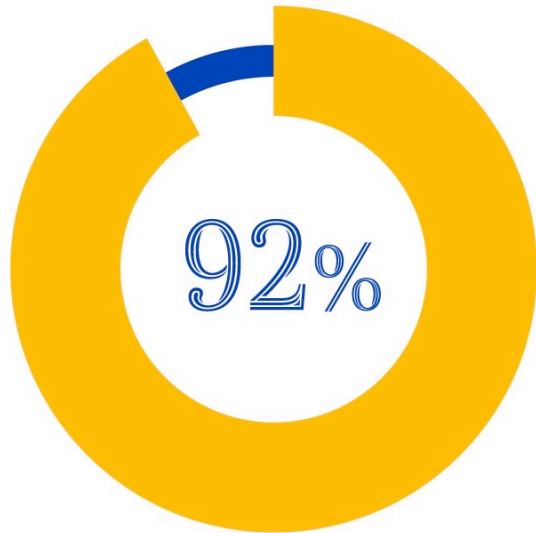
